Special Regulations for Section H

1. Waiver forms must be signed by all competitors.
2. All competitors competing in this section should take part in the **GRAND PARADE** at 3.00pm on Sunday, 18th March 2012.
3. Riders and handlers of stallions must be 18 years and over.
4. District events are only open to residents and horses of the Yass Shire.
5. Camping charges \$20 per camp per night including electricity.
6. A steward has the right to refuse entry of any competitor not correctly attired. Helmet standard – AS/NZS 3838:1998, **wearing is compulsory in all rings**, exception Sunday Ring 1 only.
7. All exhibitors must produce registration, membership and/or relevant breed and height papers on request for all classes.
8. Novice classes are for horses and/or riders that have not won a 1st place in same class at an Agricultural Show.
9. Show Hunter Classes: horses to nominate in Show Hunter or Hack classes (**cannot compete in both**)
10. Second chance ring – Champion from other Hack classes ineligible to compete.

Rules for the Pryde's Easifeed Supreme Champion Hack of Zone 3

1. The only eligible horses for this event are the Champion Ridden Hack, Champion Ridden Galloway Hack and Champion Ridden Pony Hack of the Show.
2. Show Hunter classes are **NOT ELIGIBLE**.
3. If there is a change of ownership the horse is still eligible for entry into this event.
4. No substitute horse is permissible in this event.
5. In the event that there is a draw in any event eligible for the Pryde's EasiFeed Supreme Champion Hack, Champion Galloway Hack or champion Pony Hack of Zone 3, both Horses are eligible to enter.
6. First Prize will be given in the form of a voucher to be redeemable at the winner's convenience.
7. Ribbons and Prizes will be presented to Horses from 1st to 6th.
8. The Supreme Champion Hack or Champion Galloway Hack of Zone 3 event will always be held at Queanbeyan Show.
9. If for any reason the Supreme Champion Hack or Champion Galloway Hack of Zone 3 event is unable to be held at the Queanbeyan Show, the Queanbeyan Show Society Inc. Horse Committee can nominate another venue and date.
10. The Judge's decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
11. Any competitor who desires to enter a protest against any decision, act or omission on the part of the Society, or any Official of the Society shall lodge a protest in writing within (1) one hour of event upon which the decision, act or omission occurred. The protest shall set out in detail the circumstances relied upon such Competitor, and shall be given to the Ring Secretary, accompanied by a fee of \$100, which shall be forfeited to the Society should the protest be deemed frivolous.

Special Regulations for Showjumping

1. Draw will be made 10 minutes prior to each event. Competitors must assemble in marshalling area provided prior to event and be available immediately on call.
2. To compete in official showjumping events all horses must be registered with the EFA
3. No prize money will be paid unless certificate is presented for signature.
4. Registration certificates to be presented on demand.
5. Five or less starters in any event—only 1st & 2nd prize money.
6. Junior rule does not apply.
7. Height classes—Horses may only compete in two consecutive classes.
8. Organisers may amend program where/when required if necessary.
9. Riders are required to wear helmets AS/NZS 3838:1998 and riding attire, ie shirt and tie, jacket. Jackets may be taken off at the judge's discretion.

AUSTRALIAN STOCK HORSES

Conditions of entry for ASH Classes

- 1) Horses to be fully registered with the Australian Stock Horse Society (for exceptions see Rule 2)
- 2) Horses ridden/presented by juniors (under 13 years) in classes reserved for them may enter any breed.
- 3) Horses ridden/presented by juniors (under 13 years) may not enter classes for ASH unless the horse is eligible to compete as an ASH.
- 4) All ASH competitors under 18 years must wear a safety helmet that complies with Australian Standards 2063-3:1988 others as approved by the ASHS.
- 5) All competitors to be financial members of ASHS. Proof of membership and horse registration is required and may be inspected.
- 6) Competitors of ASHLA classes must be a member of that association. Proof of membership is required and may be inspected.
- 7) Colts/Stallions two years and over to be shown with a bit and must be secured with a neck collar when tied up.
- 8) Colts/Stallions may be ridden in classes unless otherwise indicated.
- 9) Colts/Stallions may not be exhibited by members under 18 years.
