Special Regulations:

- b. Entry tickets must be attached prior to staging.
- c. Entries will be judged on commercial value and preparation for showing.
- d. Carrots, beetroot and parsnips must have at least 15cm (6") of top attached.
- e. Apples and pears to have stalks and calyx intact and may be polished.
