

#### **Special Regulations for Section H**

- 1. Waiver forms must be signed by all competitors. Wristbands will be issued once competitors have signed. No wristband, no participation.
- 2. All competitors competing in this section should take part in the **GRAND PARADE** at 3.00pm on Sunday.
- 3. Riders and handlers of stallions must be 18 years and over.
- 4. District events are only open to residents and horses of the Yass Shire.
- 5. Camping charges \$20 per camp per night including electricity.
- Helmet standard AS/NZS 3838, EN 1384 or equivalent. Wearing is compulsory in all rings, exception ASH Ring on Sunday only.
- 7. All exhibitors must produce registration, membership and/or relevant breed and height papers on request for all classes.
- 8. Novice classes are for horses and/or riders that have not won a 1st place in the same class at an Agricultural Show.
- 9. Intermediate classes means horses and/or riders that have not yet been placed in their individual events at a Royal Show.
- 10. Show Hunter Classes: horses to nominate in Show Hunter or Hack classes (cannot compete in both)
- 11. All Led Champions are eligible for the Supreme Led Horse of the Show.
- 12. All Ridden Champions are eligible for the Supreme Ridden Horse of the Show.
- 13. Judges will not be announced prior to show day.
- 14. Additional classes will only be added if there are 3 or more competitors.



#### **Special Regulations for Showjumping**

- 1. This Show will be run under EA rules.
- 2. Entries to be taken at the Pryde's Easifeed Showjumping Ring from 7am. Waiver to be completed on entering.
- 3. Riders are required to wear helmets AS/NZS 3838, EN 1384 or equivalent. Correct riding attire to be worn (ie shirt/tie/jacket). Jackets may be taken off at the judge's discretion. Correct footwear must be worn.
- 4. White board draw prior to each class.
- 5. Practice area will be on the main arena. Please adhere to the marshals' directions.
- 6. Organisers may amend the program where/when required, or if necessary.
- 7. **Mounted presentations for each class** please make yourself available asap when the results are announced.
- 8. The only class that may be **OFFICIAL** is the 1.10 class on each day, if there are 10 or more entrants. You will need your EA horse registration papers and current jump card.

  - 1.5. animal showing events will be held in close proximity to rides and large groups of people, and that there may be loud and unfamiliar noises which can frighten animals;
