9am on Saturday 21 March 2026.

Exhibits will be stewarded out after **4 pm.**

HEALTH DECLARATIONS, IF REQUIRED, WILL BE AVAILABLE ON THE DAY OF PENNING.

Special Regulations for Section P:

- a) Waiver form **must** be completed and signed before competing.
- b) Exhibits to be the bona fide property of the exhibitor for one month prior to the show. The exhibitor must make a declaration to this effect if required.
- c) Exhibits must be pure breeds – *except for Junior Pet Class*
- d) Exhibits in breeding pairs cannot compete in a single class.
- e) **Junior (Exhibitor under 18) Section must pen their own exhibits.** Junior Exhibitors may enter the open classes, but the same bird cannot be entered in both Open and Junior classes.
- f) All exhibits must be in good health, clean and be free from any disease or infestation. Please ensure Pet entries comply with this Regulation. Call the Chief Steward for any clarification.
- g) Exhibits demonstrating an illness will be withdrawn and the Exhibitor asked to remove the Exhibit from the Poultry Shed.
- h) Health declarations may be required on the day.
- i) Unfortunately, we **cannot** cater for Turkeys, Guinea Fowl or Geese.

Definitions: AC – Any colour (*recognised in the Australian Poultry Standard for that breed*);

AOV – Any other variety
